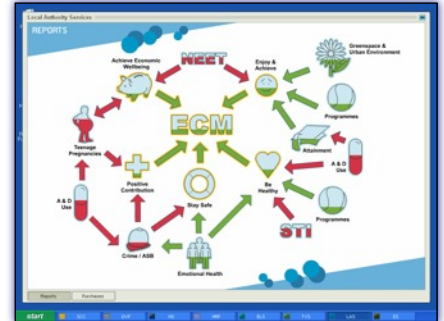

Learning Simulation on Young People's Issues

Planit-YP improves leadership and decision-making around young people's issues.

Planit-YP models the life of a community. Eight Teams play the role of key decision makers including education, health sector, emergency services and targeted youth support. The teams need to work together to sort problems such as teenage pregnancy, anti-social behaviour, worklessness, and drugs in a virtual community.

The teams consider root causes and create positive alternatives. Win-win-win solutions need to be negotiated and incidents avoided. They need to bring the community in line with the Every Child Matters agenda.

The learning simulation creates clarity and so real world improvements. Delegates consistently highlight improvements in strategic thinking, joined up thinking and collaborative working.

Objectives:

- Increasing awareness of young peoples' issues.
- Understanding the issues in terms of cause and effect rather than silo perspective.
- Broadening the design input into the Every Child Matters agenda. Including getting young people and professionals working together.
- Consider the factors associated with risky behaviours leading to teenage pregnancy.
